

**“Floral Double 9-Patch”**  
 From Fraser Valley Quilters’ Guild  
 Focus fabric from The Attic Window

**9”x 9” block (9 ½” sq. unfinished)**

1. Cut **One** 3 ½” x 3 ½” square Floral Print (focus fabric provided)
2. Cut **One** 22” x 1 ½” strip Medium Green  
 Cut **Two** 22” x 1 ½” strips White or Ivory (tone on tone)
3. Cut **Two** 13” x 1 ½” strips Dark Pink, Yellow or Lavender – match to focus fabric  
 Cut **One** 13” x 1 ½” strip White or Ivory (tone on tone from step 2)

With an accurate ¼” seam, sew a white 22” strip to each side of the green 22” strip. Press seams towards the green.

From these sewn strips, cut four 3 ½” sections (A), and Four 1 ½” sections (B).

Sew together the 13” strips, with the white in the center.

Cut Eight 1 ½” sections (C).

Piece blocks as illustrated, pressing all seams towards the darker colors (see arrows).
