

## Sister Pinwheel Block

Focus Fabric from Dee's Country Accents

Cutting Instructions: Cut **two 4 3/8" squares** and **four 2 1/2" x 4"** pieces from each of the **two** colors.

Assembly:

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light (fabric #1) 4 3/8" squares. Place the squares right sides together with the darker (focus fabric #2) 4 3/8" squares. Sew 1/4" seams along each side of the diagonal line and then cut on the line – making two half square triangles. Repeat this with the remaining 4 3/8" square. Press seams towards the darker fabric.
- 2) Arrange the four half square triangles with the diagonals oriented in the same direction and cut each into 2" wide segments (on the dotted lines) for a total of eight, see **Diagram 1**.

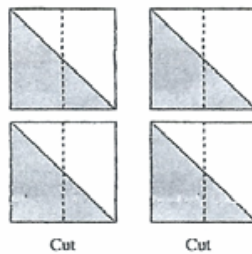

- 3) Following **Diagram 2**, sew a matching 2 1/2" x 4" dark (#2) piece to each of the lighter (#1) with the darker corners to make 4 units. Press seams towards the darker pieces. Then stitch the lighter 2 1/2" x 4" pieces to the darker segments with the lighter corners to make 4 units. Press seams towards the lighter pieces.

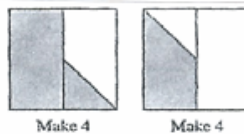
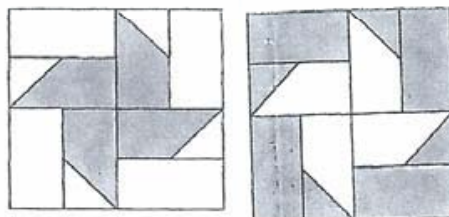

- 4) Referring to the Block Diagram and noting the orientation, sew the blocks together to make one block with a dark pinwheel and one with a light pinwheel. Now you have the Sister Blocks.
