

NCW Quilt Guild Comfort Quilt Block
April 2009 Twin Sisters
12" Finished (12 1/2" unfinished)

Please use bright, clear colors for this fun quilt block. It is an easy block but different than past blocks, please take your time and follow the photographs and instructions.

Cutting:

A) Focus fabric provided: cut one @ 7 1/4" square – cut diagonally twice

B & C) Pick two colors from the dots on the focus fabric: cut one @ 4 3/4" x 14 1/2" rectangle of each of the two fabrics you have chosen

Sewing:

- 1) Pin one "A" triangle to each end and opposite sides of the "B" & "C" rectangles, following picture for placement. Repeat with second rectangle.

- 2) Sew the triangles onto the rectangles as shown by the arrows above. Press to the focus fabric.

- 3) Place the 45 degree line (see arrow) of your large ruler on the seam line as shown in the photo and cut a large triangle, matching the edge of the ruler to the angle of the focus fabric. Turn ruler and repeat on opposite side. There will be less than 1/4" of fabric wasted between the two cuts. Repeat with second rectangle, making 4 large triangles.
- 4) Lay triangles out to complete the block. Sew 2 alternate units together to make half your block, repeat with the other 2 triangle units. Lay the two halves together and sew.



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
