

NCWQG Block Exchange
November 2009
Picket Fence from 501 Rotary-Cut Quilt Blocks
12" finished (12 1/2" unfinished)

Cut:

Focus – Blue and green swirls: cut 1 @ 7" square (C)

White – Fairy Frost: cut 1 @ 7" square (A)

Light – chose a blue, green or silver: cut 2 @ 4 1/2" square (B)

Dark – chose a blue or green: cut 2 @ 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" (D)

cut 2 @ 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" (E)

Sew:

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on the back of unit A – 7" white and layer on unit C, right sides together. Sew 1/4" from each side of the line, cut on line and press to the blue. Square both HST blocks to 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".
- 2) Sew an E rectangle to the left side of each 4 1/2" B unit. Press to the dark. Place the D rectangle on the top of each E/B unit and sew. Press to the dark. These two units should measure 6 1/2" square.



- 3) Lay block out as per photo. Sew an E/B unit to a HST unit, press away from the HST. Finish your block by sewing the top and bottom rows together and press. Your block should measure 12 1/2" unfinished.
