

N.C.W.Q.G. Raffle Block 2005

Spring Basket

Block is 10" finished 10 1/2" unfinished

Background fabric- light tan or muslin

Cut 1- 2 1/2" square, Cut 3- 2 7/8" squares cut these in half on the diagonal once, you will have 6 triangles, Cut 2- 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" Cut 1- 4 7/8" square cut in half on the diagonal you will only use one triangle.

The flower fabric is cut to size.

Basket fabric- Pastels, you can choose one of the colors from the flowered fabric if you like, but not red.

Cut 4- 2 7/8" squares cut these in half on the diagonal once, you will have 8 triangles. For the large basket triangle you may cut a 6 7/8" square cut in half on the diagonal and discard one triangle or you may lay the flower fabric on the basket fabric to use as a pattern, being careful not to cut the flower fabric.

PUTTING THE BLOCK TOGETHER

Sew the large basket triangle and the flower triangle together. It should measure 6 1/2".

Set aside 2 basket triangles. Sew the 6 together with a background triangle. These should measure 2 1/2" square. Using the picture as a guide, sew 3 together for the left side. Sew to the large square. Using the picture as a guide, sew 3 together for the top adding the background square on the left. Sew to the block.

Take the two triangles that you set aside and using the picture as a guide, sew a basket triangle to the bottom of each 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" piece. Sew these to the basket. Sew the background triangle to the bottom of the basket.

There you are all finished now isn't that pretty!!!!!!
