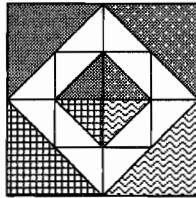

January 2007 Raffle Block

Friendship Scrap Block

12-1/2" unfinished



Fabrics:

Colors 1, 2, 3, 4 - choose four fabrics that are darker than Color 5 - one strip 7-1/2" x 11-1/2" per color

✂ From each color cut one 7" square and one 4" square

✂ Cut each square on the diagonal to make two large half square triangles and two small half square triangles (you will only use one triangle per size per color)

**Color 5 - Provided**

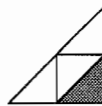
✂ Cut six 4" squares

✂ Cut each square on the diagonal to make 12 small half square triangles

1. Sew Color 5 small half square triangles to each color 1, 2, 3, 4 small triangle using a SCANT  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Press towards the darker fabric. Trim each half square to 3-1/2".



2. Sew Color 5 small half square triangle to the left side and one to the top side to the half square.



3. Sew the large half square triangles to complete the square. Press seam allowance towards the Color 1 half square triangle. The square should measure 6-1/2".



4. Repeat this step using Color 2, 3 and 4 half squares.
5. Piece the four units to make the block.

***PLEASE DO NOT SQUARE UP YOUR BLOCK - LET THE PERSON WHO WINS THE BLOCKS DO THAT***
