



NCW Quilt Guild  
October Block Exchange  
Friendship Star Variation  
12 ½" Block (12" finished block)

Fabrics:

A) Polka Dots – Background – provided: cut four 5" squares 

B) Medium – pick a color from the dots for Star: cut two 5" squares and one 4 ½" square 

C) Dark – for corners: cut two 5" squares 

Sew:

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the four Polka Dot squares. Layer each square, right sides together onto each of the two dark and two medium 5" squares.
- 2) Sew ¼" from each side of the diagonal lines. Cut on the diagonal line and press to the dark/medium fabrics.
- 3) Square each block to 4 ½".
- 4) Following the diagram below, lay out the blocks.
- 5) Sew each row, pressing each row in alternate directions. Sew the rows together, pressing in to the center.
- 6) Your block should measure 12 ½".
