Summer Pinwheel  
12" finished (12 1/2" unfinished)  
Fabric from Dee's Country Accents

This month's block is one of the easiest and quickest blocks to make. With vacations and grandkids visiting, I thought a simple block would be best. And this fabric just calls for a simple block. Fabric is Moda's Colorplay. As it is a busy fabric, please pick out a tone on tone print or marble to coordinate with the Colorplay fabric.

Cutting:

- A) Colorplay provided: cut 2 @ 7" square
- B) Tone on tone: cut 2 @ 7" square

Sewing:

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of your tone on tone squares. Layer the A and B blocks, right sides together. Sew 1/4" seam, on both sides of the diagonal line.
- 2) Cut on the diagonal line, press to the A fabric. Make four half square triangle blocks, square to 6 1/2".



Make 4 HSTs.

- 3) Lay the four blocks out following the diagram. Sew each row together, press to the A fabric. Sew each half together. Block should measure 12 1/2" unfinished.
