**The Crayon Box** – 501 Rotary Cut Quilt Blocks  
Bonus Block November 2009  
Fabric donated by a guild member

This is our twelfth and final block for 2009. If you have been making blocks each month with your “Why did I buy this” fabric, this will give you enough to make a throw sized quilt. Assemble your blocks as you like. If you are unsure, check out any magazine or book for a simple 12 block setting idea. If you have EQ, play around and see what you can come up with. Add borders and finish your quilt. Then, bring in your completed quilt for Show and Tell at the next guild meeting, and present to the new Comfort Quilts committee. And thank you for the work you have done.

**Cut:**

Focus apple fabric: cut 1 @ 4 ½” square (A)

Tan medium light: cut 2 @ 2 ½” x 6 ½” (B)

cut 2 @ 2 ½” x 4 ½” (C)

Medium value: cut 2 @ 2 ½” x 6 ½” (D)

cut 2 @ 2 ½” x 4 ½” (E)

Dark Brown: cut 2 @ 2 ½” x 8 ½” (F)

cut 2 @ 2 ½” x 4 ½” (G)

**Sew:**

- 1) Sew a dark brown G (2 ½” x 4 ½”) to each side of the A apple fabric. Press out. Sew a dark brown F (2 ½” x 8 ½”) to the top and bottom of this unit. Press out.
- 2) Sew your B & D (2 ½” x 6 ½”) units together. Press to the darker fabric. Sew your C & E (2 ½” x 4 ½”) units together. Press to the darker fabric.
- 3) Following the photo, sew an E/C unit (E on top) to the left side of the block. Sew the other E/C unit (C on top) to the right side of the block. Press in.
- 4) Sew your B/D units (B on left) to top of block and (D on left) to bottom of block. Press in. Your block should measure 12 ½” unfinished.
