

NCW Quilt Guild October 2009 Block Exchange
Antique Tile (Variation) – Quilter's Cache
12" Finished (12 1/2" unfinished)
Fabric donated by guild member

Focus Fabric provided (A): Cut one @ 4 1/2" square
Cut four @ 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
Cut one @ 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Accent fabric (B) pink, lilac or yellow: Cut one @ 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Background – soft white (C): Cut one @ 2 1/2" x 18 1/2"
2nd Accent – green (D): Cut one @ 2 1/2" x 18 1/2"

- 1) Layer A & B – 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" pieces and sew together. Press to B fabric. Cut into four 2 1/2" strips (diagram 1). Sew a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" piece of focus fabric (A) to the left side of two 2 patch strips. Sew a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" piece of A to the right side of the two 2 patch strips (diagram 2). Press towards the 2 patch. Units should measure 4 1/2" square.

- 2) Layer C & D – 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" pieces and sew together. Press to the green (D). Cut into four @ 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces.
- 3) Lay out block as per diagram. Sew horizontal rows together, pressing top and bottom row seams out and center row seams in. Sew each row together and press seams. Block should measure 12 1/2" unfinished (12" finished).
