

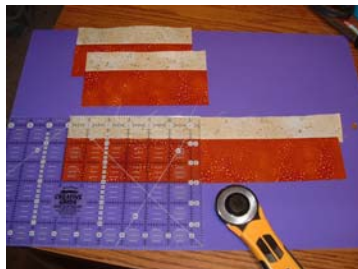
NCW October Bonus Block
Hole in the Barn Door – Quilter’s Cache (variation)
12” Finished (12 ½” unfinished)
Leaf fabric – Craft Warehouse
Cream background – Attic Window

Focus leaf fabric (A): cut one 6 ½” square

Accent fabric (leaf colors) (B): cut 2 @ 4” square
Cut 2 @ 2 ½” x 13 ¼”

Background cream fabric (C): cut 2 @ 4” square
Cut 2 @ 1 ½” x 13 ¼”

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on the two 4” square background pieces. Sew ¼” on each side of the line. Cut on the line and press to the accent (B) fabric. Square each half square triangle (HST) to 3 ½” square. Make 4 HST units.
- 2) Layer the two 2 ½” x 13 ¼” strips with the two 1 ½” x 13 ¼” strips. Sew each pair of strips. Press to the accent (B) fabric. Cut four @ 6 ½”. You will have 4 @ 3 ½” x 6 ½” units.



- 3) Lay your block out as per the photo. Sew a HST unit to the ends of each unit from step #2. The accent (B) fabrics will all be on the inside. Press to the center unit. Sew a 3 ½” x 6 ½” unit to each side of the center square. Press out.
- 4) Sew each row together pressing to the center block. Your finished block should measure 12 ½”.
