

NCWQG Block Exchange
February 2010
Maverick Churn Dash from Quick Quilts magazine September 2009
12" Finished (12 1/2" Unfinished)
Fabric donated by guild members

Please **do not trim** your block when you are finished with it. This will allow the winner of the Blocks a bit more leeway in putting the blocks together.

Dark fabric (A): cut one @ 4 1/2" square
cut two strips @ 2 1/2" x 10"
cut two 5" squares (for HST)

Background fabric provided is a variety of light tone on tone.

Background fabric (B): cut two 5" squares (for HST)
cut two strips @ 2 1/2" x 10"

1) Draw a diagonal line on back of the two 5" sq. fabric (B). Put fabric A & B, 5" squares right sides together & sew 1/4" on each side of the line. Cut on the line and press to dark fabric (A). Square each half square triangle (HST) to 4 1/2" square. Make 4 HST units.

2) Layer the two 2 1/2" x 10" A & B fabric strips together and sew. Press to the dark fabric. Cut four @ 4 1/2". You will have four at 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" units.



3) Lay your block out as per the photo. Sew a HST unit to the ends of each unit from step #2. Press toward center. Sew a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" unit to each side of the 4 1/2" center square. Press out.

4) Sew each row together pressing to the center block. Please do not trim your finished block.
