

NCWQG Block Exchange  
Churn Dash - May 2010  
12" Finished (12 1/2" unfinished)  
Fabric provided by Comfort Quilts

Please **do not trim** your block when you are finished with it. This will allow a bit more leeway in putting the blocks together.

When you return the block(s), it will be given to Comfort Quilts for assembly and distribution as needed. You are being provided enough background fabric for **two blocks**. Comfort Quilts would like to get enough blocks to assemble a "man" quilt and a "woman" quilt. Would you please make one block for a man and one block for a woman? Thanks and happy quilting.

For one block:

Novelty focus fabric (A): Cut one 4 1/2" square (for center)

Framing fabric (B):

Cut two 5" squares (HST)

Cut four 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" rectangles

Background fabric **provided** (C):

Cut two 5" squares (to make 4 HST for corners)

Cut four 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" rectangles

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on back of fabric (C) 5" squares. Put fabric B & C 5" squares right sides together & sew scant 1/4" on each side of the line. Cut on the line & press to dark fabric (B). Square each half square (HST) to 4 1/2". Makes 4 HST.
- 2) Sew fabric B & C 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" rectangles together lengthwise, to form 4 1/2" square. Press seam to dark fabric.
- 3) Layout your block as shown below.
- 4) Sew pieces together to form block. Please do not trim your finished block.
