Scholarship Changes

In order to make the Guild Scholarship more available to our members, the Scholarship committee has made a recommendation to the membership to open eligibility to any member pursuing a post-secondary education. The suggested changes were presented at the June general meeting, and will be voted on by the membership at the August meeting.

This is what the committee is proposing:

Description:

A scholarship in support of post-secondary education, either continuous, delayed entry, or re-entry, where enrollment is no less than half-time at a technical or trade school, 2-year community college, or 4-year college or university.

One scholarship for \$750 will be offered each year, and is a one-year award.

The scholarship can be won only once by each person.

The scholarship application must earn a minimum score to be considered for the award.

Unsuccessful applicants may re-apply each year they are eligible.

Eligibility:

NCWQG members who have current membership and have been a member since at least January of the previous calendar year.

Graduating HS seniors or currently-enrolled college students who are close relatives (child, grandchild, 1st generation niece or nephew) of members if they are continuing into or through post-secondary education without a break. The Guild member relative must meet the same membership criteria as a member applicant.

Chelan, Douglas, or Grant County resident.

Current enrollment, or possession of a letter of acceptance.

Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 from the last school attended.
