
## Quilts of Valor Foundation 24 Hour National Sew Day

Looking for a winter project? Check out the NCW Quilt Guild's library which is in a cabinet that has been moved to the classroom area of Sew Creative which is across the street from Lewis & Clark Elementary. As you go into the store, go toward the fabric and turn right. The classroom is straight ahead and the cabinet is to the left.

Choose the Your Books tab which will pull up the books in the library. You can browse through the titles or you can do a search using titles or authors.

To Search: Type search terms into Search Your Library box. Click on Search you will get a list. Click on title to see details, summary, and reviews. You can also click books under Your Books to see all the books in the library.

To check out a book, e-mail request to: <u>paine.s@applecapital.net</u> or call 663-4006. I will bring the book to the next meeting. Or you can go to **Sew Creative.** The books are arranged alphabetically by title in a cabinet there. If you find a book there and want to check it out, write your name, phone number, and the date on the card in the front of the book. Leave the cared in the box on the bottom shelf. You can return the book to the cabinet or bring it to a monthly meeting and give it to Sharon Paine.

#### New Book:

If you are interested in Bargello quilts this book might interest you. <u>Jelly Roll Bargello</u> Quilts (Landauer) Clear How-To Instructions for a Beginner-Friendly, Easy-to-Learn <u>Technique to Create a Mesmerizing Optical Illusion of Graceful Movement, Waves, & Curves</u> by Karin Hellaby.

"Fascinating Bargello quilts consist entirely of straight seams and rectangular pieces, yet create the mesmerizing optical illusion of graceful movement, waves, and curves. Bargello quilt making looks complex and difficult-but any beginner quilter who can sew a straight seam can master the necessary skills. It is also a technique that is easy to complete quickly and with confidence, thanks to pre-cut jelly rolls."

#### Comfort Quilts



Thank you to everyone that generously donated your time and fabric to make our Comfort Quilts possible. We donated 132 quilts in 2018 to the following: Palliative Care, Linus, Veterans in wheel chairs, Chief for the day, CASA, Habitat for Humanity, The Bruce Hotel, Grace House and a few special requests. We have quite a few finished quilts in storage but many do not meet the sizes most requested; palliative 40" x 60", wheel chair 40" x 40" and twins minimum 60" x 80". We are especially low on Palliative quilts 40"x 60" at this time. We will have several kits of various sizes available for quilting at the next meeting. Palliative quilts are small enough to be quilted on a regular machine and need not be fancy. We would like to have the quilted quilts returned the following month but we realized everyone is busy and unexpected things happen so if you need an additional month that is Ok. We have been asked if they can only be picked up and returned at a meeting. If you find you have some extra time please let us

know we will make arrangements get a quilting kit to you or if you have a completed quilt but are unable make a meeting we would be happy to make arrangements to get it.






